Jonathan Arthur "Chico" DeBarge is an R&B singer and a younger brother of the members of the Motown family act DeBarge. He will bring his style and music to the City of Roses on Friday, Nov. 8 at the Ambridge Event Center, 1333 N.E. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.

Unlike the rest of his DeBarge siblings, Chico is the only male DeBarge that does not sing in the falsetto range that is well known in his family; he sings tenor.

The Detroit native began a musical career of his own with Motown in the mid-1980s. His debut self-titled album featured the hit single "Talk To Me." He released a second album with Motown, Kiss Serious, but was imprisoned for drug charges not long after.

After his release in the mid-1990s,

DeBarge returned to Motown to continue his musical career.

He later released Free in 2003 and contributed a song to the Beauty Shop movie soundtrack. His most recent album Addiction was released in 2009.

Debut Film at the Clinton

Portland will be one of the first markets to see the new award-winning independent film "JFK: A President Betrayed."

Narrated by Academy Award winner Morgan Freeman, the film uncovers new evidence that reveals how President John F. Kennedy reversed U.S. government policy to embark on secret back-channel peace efforts with Nikita Khrushchev, Fidel Castro and other sworn American enemies.
