Magical Ballets for the Holiday

This Thanksgiving weekend, young dancers from The Portland Ballet and the Portland State University Symphony present two magical ballets, the holiday favorite *The Enchanted Toyshop*, and the thrilling *Firebird*. Choreographer John Clifford's 2005 *Firebird* brings the highly dramatic elements of danger, beauty, tragedy and romance. The Portland Ballet nurtures young dancers

from age three to 19.

To expand audiences throughout the city, 100 pay-what-you-will tickets will be available at each show, giving everyone a chance to experience the arts, no matter their budget. Available at the PSU Lincoln Hall box office one hour before each show, the tickets are good for open seating and cost \$5, plus an optional donation. Adult tickets usually cost \$35.

A preview performance on Friday, Nov. 29 at 4 p.m. will have only pay-what-you-will tickets, which can be reserved by calling the Lincoln Hall box office. The other shows are the opening night production on Friday, Nov. 29 at 7 p.m.; Saturday, Nov. 30 at 1 p.m. and 4 p.m.; and Sunday, Dec. 1 at 1 p.m. and 4 p.m.
