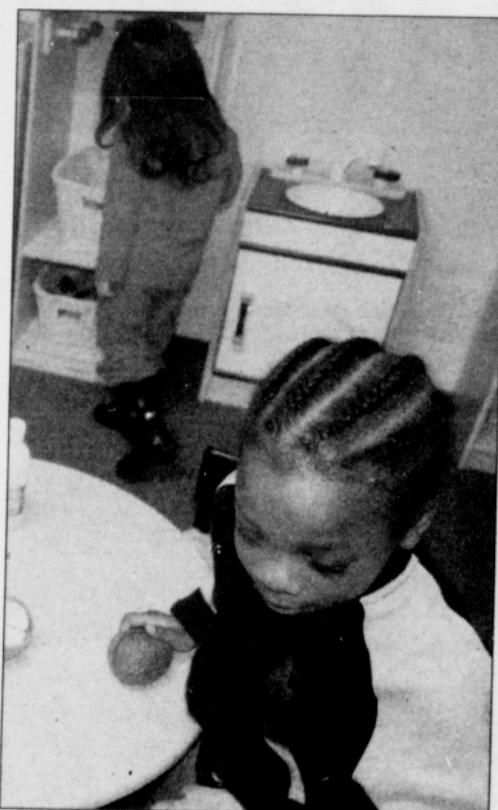
Shaking Up Sports

On the Brink

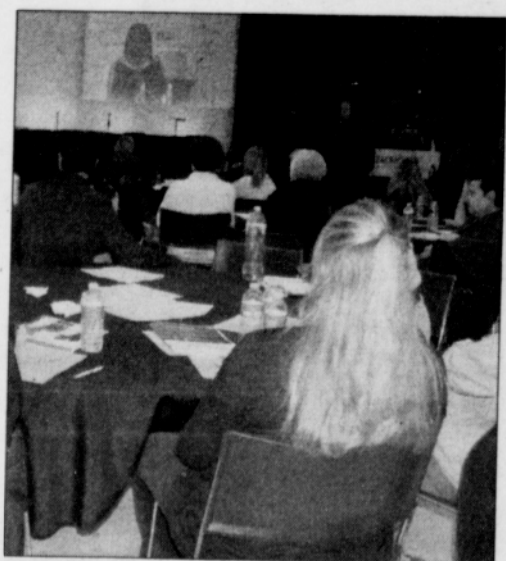

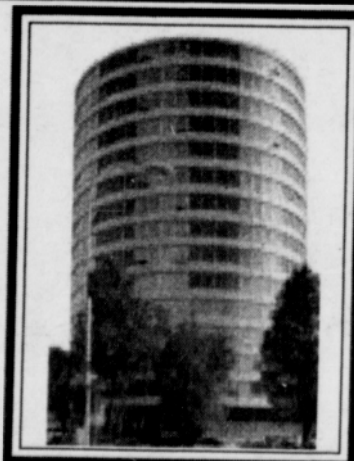

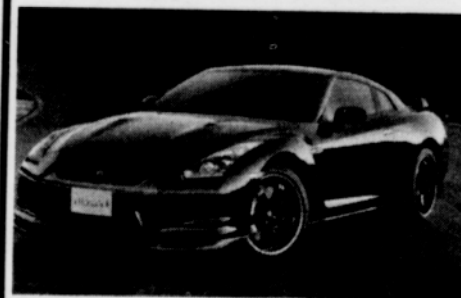
