1929

- **Born:** Jan. 15, 1929.
- **Parents:** The Rev. and Mrs. Martin Luther King Sr.
- **Home:** 501 Auburn Avenue, N.E., Atlanta, Georgia.

1944

- Graduated from Booker T. Washington High School and was admitted to Morehouse College at age 15.

1948

- Graduates from Morehouse College and enters Crozer Theological Seminary.
- Ordained to the Baptist ministry at age 19.

1951

- Enters Boston University for graduate studies.



1953

- Marries Coretta Scott and settles in Montgomery, Ala.
