Flu Shots for free on the MLK Holiday

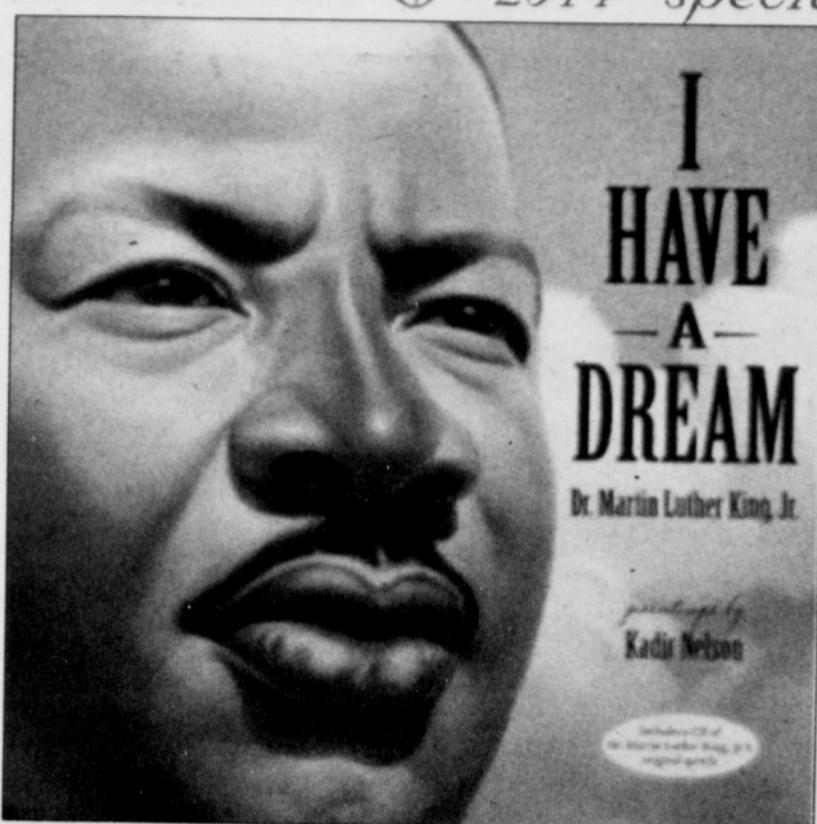

Luther King Holiday, Monday, Jan. 20 will provide free flu vaccinations to help protect yourself and your loved ones.

Legacy Emanuel Medical Center, 2801 N. Gantenbein, in partnership with Immunize Oregon and the Multnomah County Immunization Program is offering free flu shots to people age six months and older from 11 a.m. till 3 p.m.

At the Legacy Emanuel event, people age 12 and older may also receive a free tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis vaccination.

FamilyCare, Inc., a Medicare and Medicaid managed care organization, will hold a free flu clinic, also open to the public, on the MLK holiday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the Lloyd Center Mall at Center Court on Level 1 near the ice rink.
