The top four names under consideration for the new transit bridge under construction over the Willamette River, downtown, have historic and cultural significance. They are Abigail Scott Duniway, a pioneer activist in the right for women to vote in Oregon; Cascadia Crossing, for the Pacific Northwest's Cascade Mountains; and Tillicum Crossing and Wy'east, two names rooted in Native American history and language.
