Notice is hereby given that the City of Vancouver, Washington, will receive sealed bids up to the hour of 11:00 a.m., Pacific Local Time, Tuesday, February 25, 2014, and publicly opened and read aloud at that time on the same day in the Vancouver City Hall, 415 W 6th Street, Vancouver, Washington, for the following:

Contractor shall install 15 curb extension bioretention stormwater facilities, including, plants. The Contractor shall also install a landscaped median, including irrigation and plants. The Contractor shall complete all other work included in the project plans.

The work under the contract shall be fully completed within 45 working days.

The work shall be fully completed by June 30, 2014.

There will be a **non-mandatory pre-bid conference and site visit on Thursday, February 13, 2014 at 9:00 a.m.**, that will begin at the City of Vancouver's Operations Center conference room located at 4711 E 4th Plain Blvd, Vancouver, WA. 98661

Incomplete submissions or submissions received after the deadline will not be considered. If required, an addendum addressing questions and requests for clarification will be issued no later than FEBRUARY 19, 2014.

It is anticipated that this project will be funded, in part, by the Washington State Department of Ecology's FY2011 Stormwater Retrofit and Low Impact Development (LID) Competitive Grant Program. Neither the State of Washington nor any of its departments or employees are, or shall be, a party to any contract or any subcontract resulting from this solicitation for bids.

Bids shall be in accordance with the specifications and other contract documents on file in Procurement Services, phone (360) 487-8430. Bid results may be obtained within 24 hours after the bid opening by accessing our website, shown above. All bids shall be delivered to the attention of the Procurement Services Manager, City of Vancouver, P. O. Box 1995, Vancouver, Washington 98668 or 415 W 6th Street. Bids shall be placed in an envelope which is sealed and which clearly states the name of the bidder, the date of the bid opening, and appropriate wording to indicate definitely the nature of the contents. Do not send bids by FAX or email. Bids submitted via FAX or email will not be accepted.

The City of Vancouver is committed to providing equal opportunities to State of Washington certified Minority, Disadvantaged and Women's Business Enterprises in contracting activities. (Section 4 of Chapter 56, Laws of 1975, 1st Ex. Sess., State of Washington).

Contractor shall register and enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Department of Homeland Security E-Verify program within sixty (60) days after execution of this Agreement. Contractor shall ensure all Contractor employees and any sub-contractor(s) assigned to perform work under this Agreement are eligible to work in the United States. Contractor shall provide verification of compliance upon City request. Failure by Contractor to comply with this subsection shall be considered a material breach.

All bid proposals must be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Vancouver.

The City of Vancouver reserves the right to cancel this invitation or reject any and all bids submitted or to waive any minor formalities of this call if in the judgment of the City Council the best interest of the City would be served.

No bidder may withdraw his/her bid after the hour set for the opening thereof, unless the award of contract is delayed for a period exceeding forty-five (45) days. If it is determined to be in the best interest of the city, the city reserves the right to request an extension of bid prices during the review process.
