

Known for his burning, highspeed, off-balance movement, Stephen Petronio has long been admired for his dynamic collaborations with iconic musicians like Laurie Anderson, Lou Reed, Nick Cave and Rufus Wainwright as well as visual artists Cindy Sherman and Anish Kapoor, among many others.

This will be the sixth time that White Bird has presented this choreographer's work, more than any other in White Bird's 16-year history.
