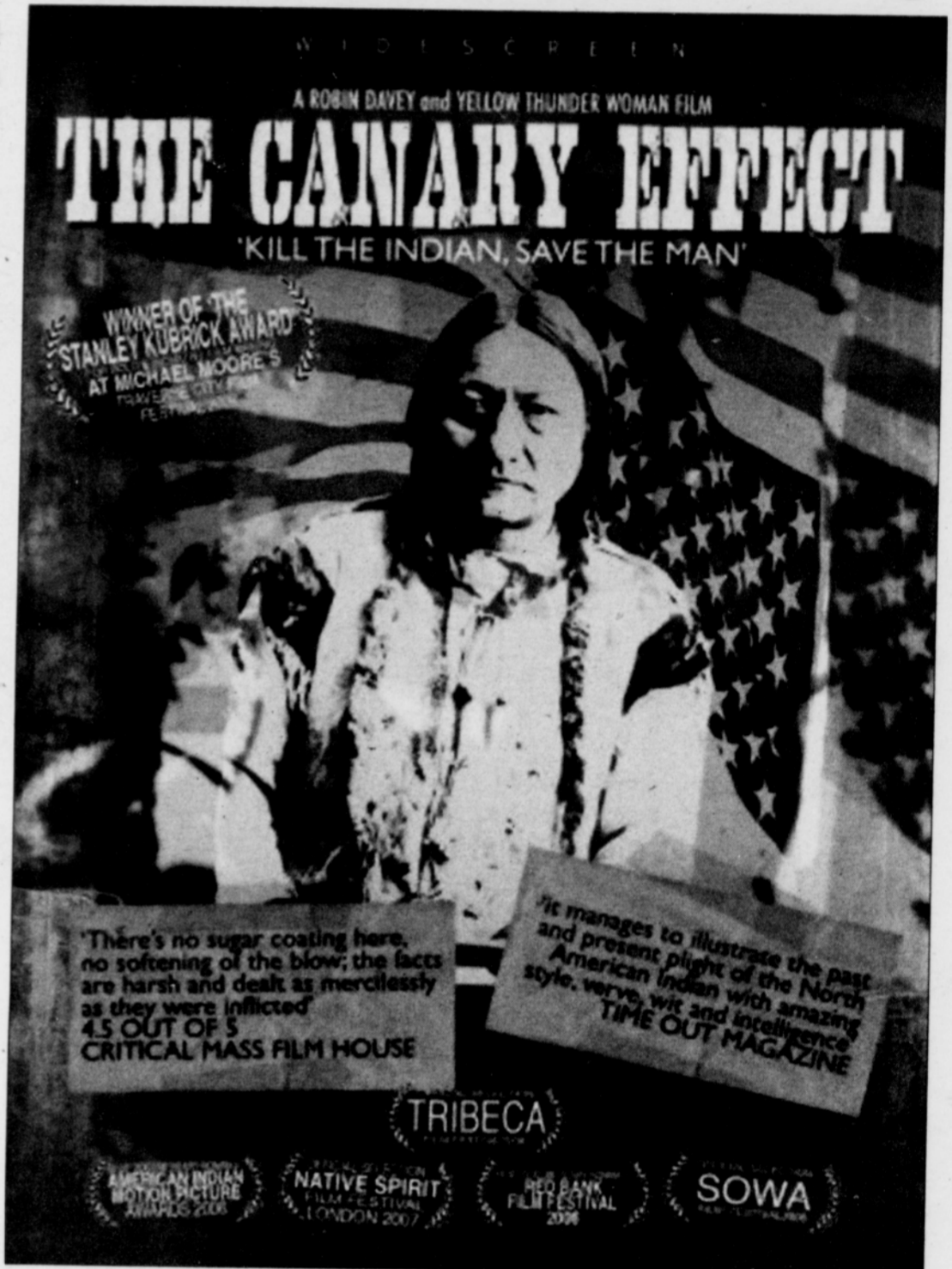
Multicultural Film Series Screening

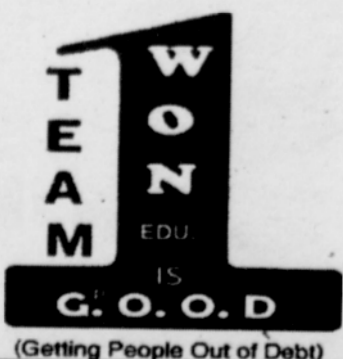
