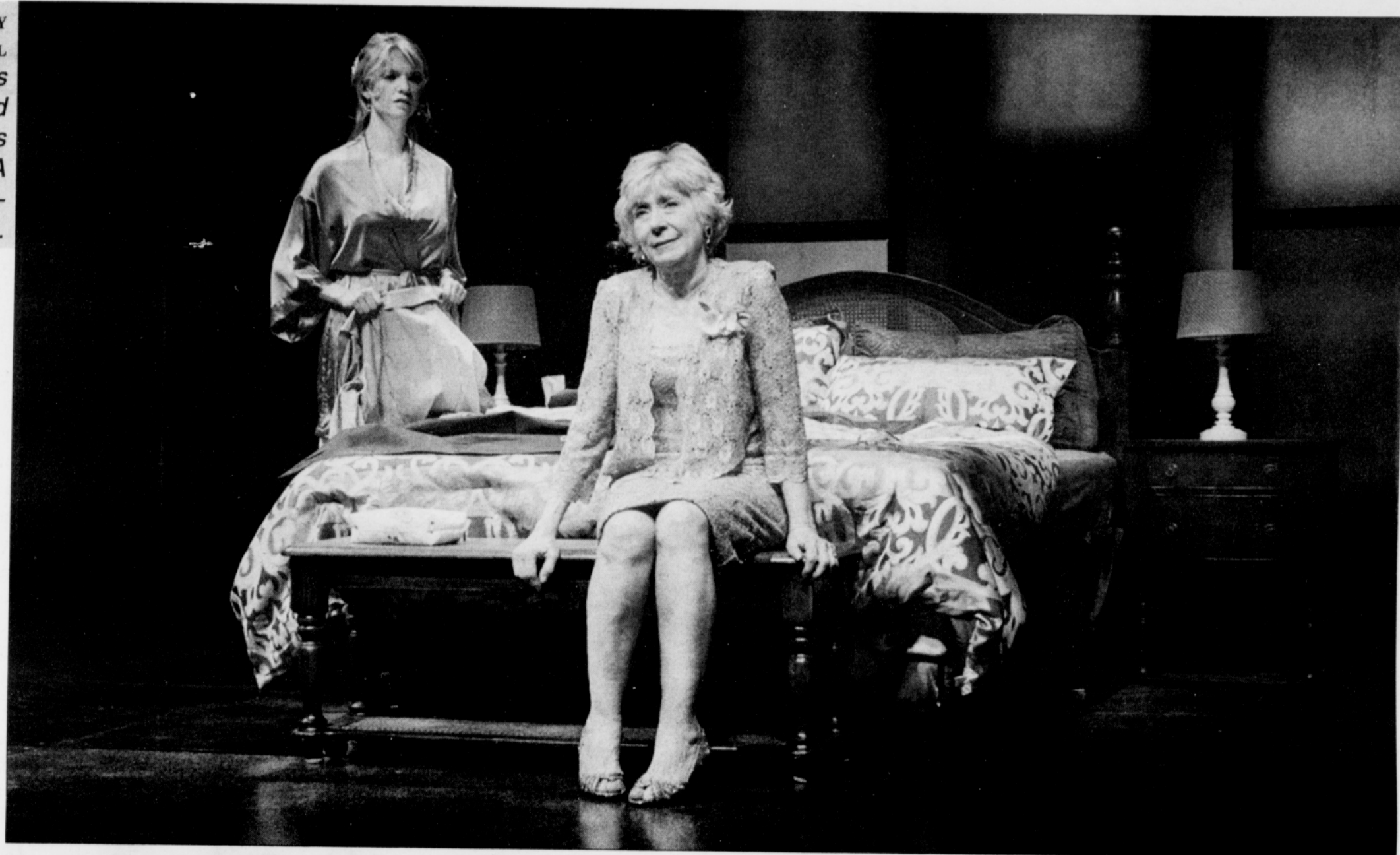

Spirit and Love of Family

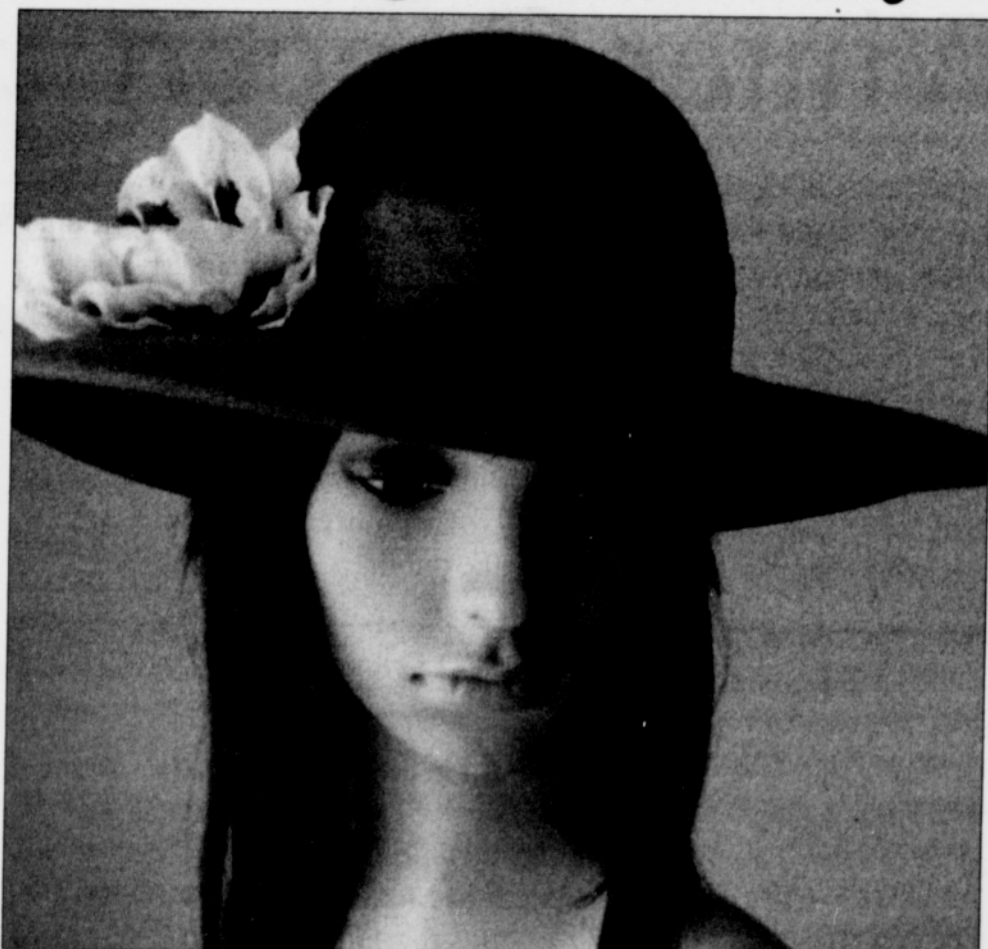
