The Multnomah Youth Commission's Youth Against Violence Committee will host

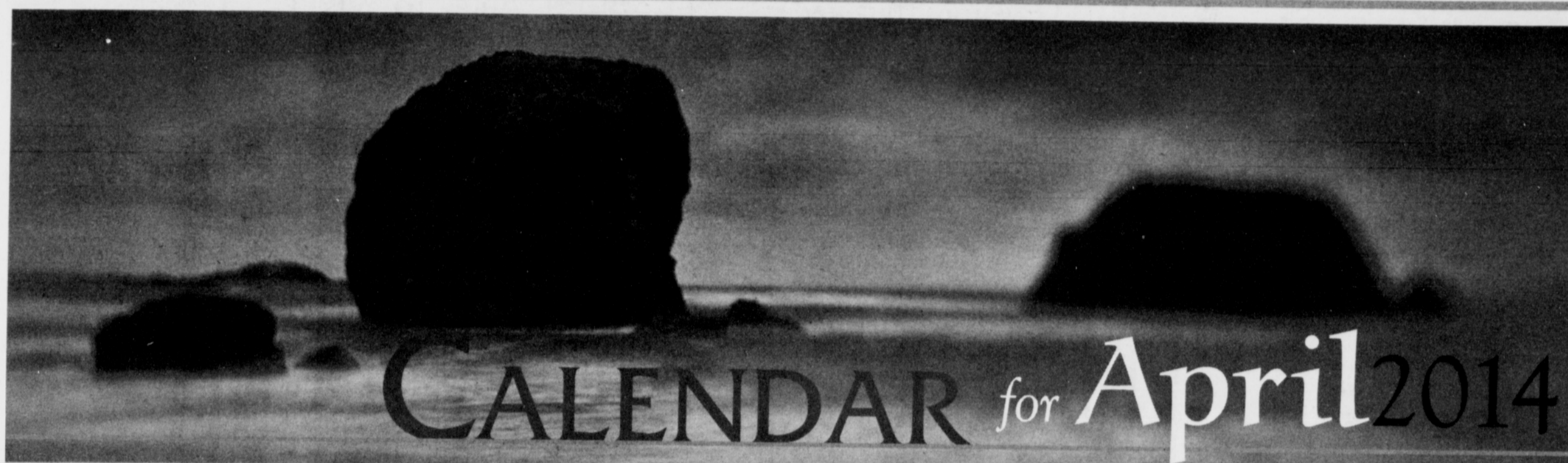
its third annual Rob Ingram Youth Summit Against Violence, Saturday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Ambridge Event Center, 1333 N.E. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.

The commission established the Rob Ingram Youth Summit after the 2011 shooting death of

Shiloh Hampton, 14. The intention was to integrate youth and adults in the work our community does to prevent violence.

Events are free for youth ages 21 and under, with shuttle bus serve to the summit departing from many area schools and com-
