

PSU Strike Evaded

Portland State University and the teacher's union reached a tentative agreement on Sunday to avoid a strike. If approved all faculty salaries would be increased to a minimum of \$40,000 annually.

Mudslide Death Toll

A massive mudslide in Washington last month has now officially claimed 33 lives, Snohomish County medical advisers reported on Monday. President Obama plans to visit the disaster site in the town of Oso-later this month.
