## Evening of Silent Films

The Oregon Historical Society presents an evening of silent film on Thursday, April 24 at 7 p.m. at the Hollywood Theatre. General admission is \$8, and tickets are available at the door.

This special screening celebrates recent preservation efforts, notably the restoration of the 1914 silent film *The Boy Mayor*, Hollywood's examination of the trials and tribulations of Portland's underage shadow government.

The five films that will be shown are among the thousands held within the historical society's Moving Images Collection, and will feature live piano accompaniment by the group's Library Director Geoff Wexler.

The other films featured will be *Sick of Life/Mephisto's Son*, a 1900 film about the devil's son becoming disillusion with life in hell; *Gold* (1922), a story about a hungry family coming to grips with the harsh realities of life in an Oregon prospecting camp; a *Calumet Baking Powder Advertisement* (date unknown); and Raymond Roger's home movies from 1935 to 1950, which include a 23rd Avenue streetcar, Ringling Brothers Circus, Blue Mouse Theater, Vanport Flood, and more.
