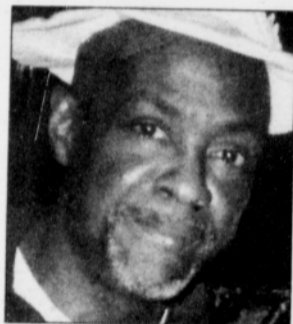
Timothy "T" Johnson

at Bethel

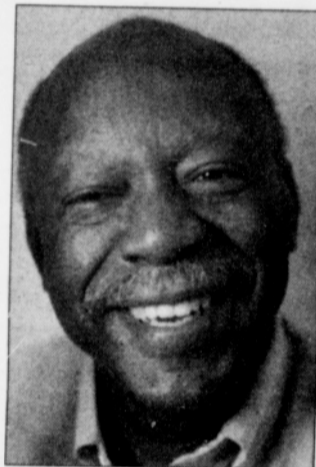
Charles Jordan
