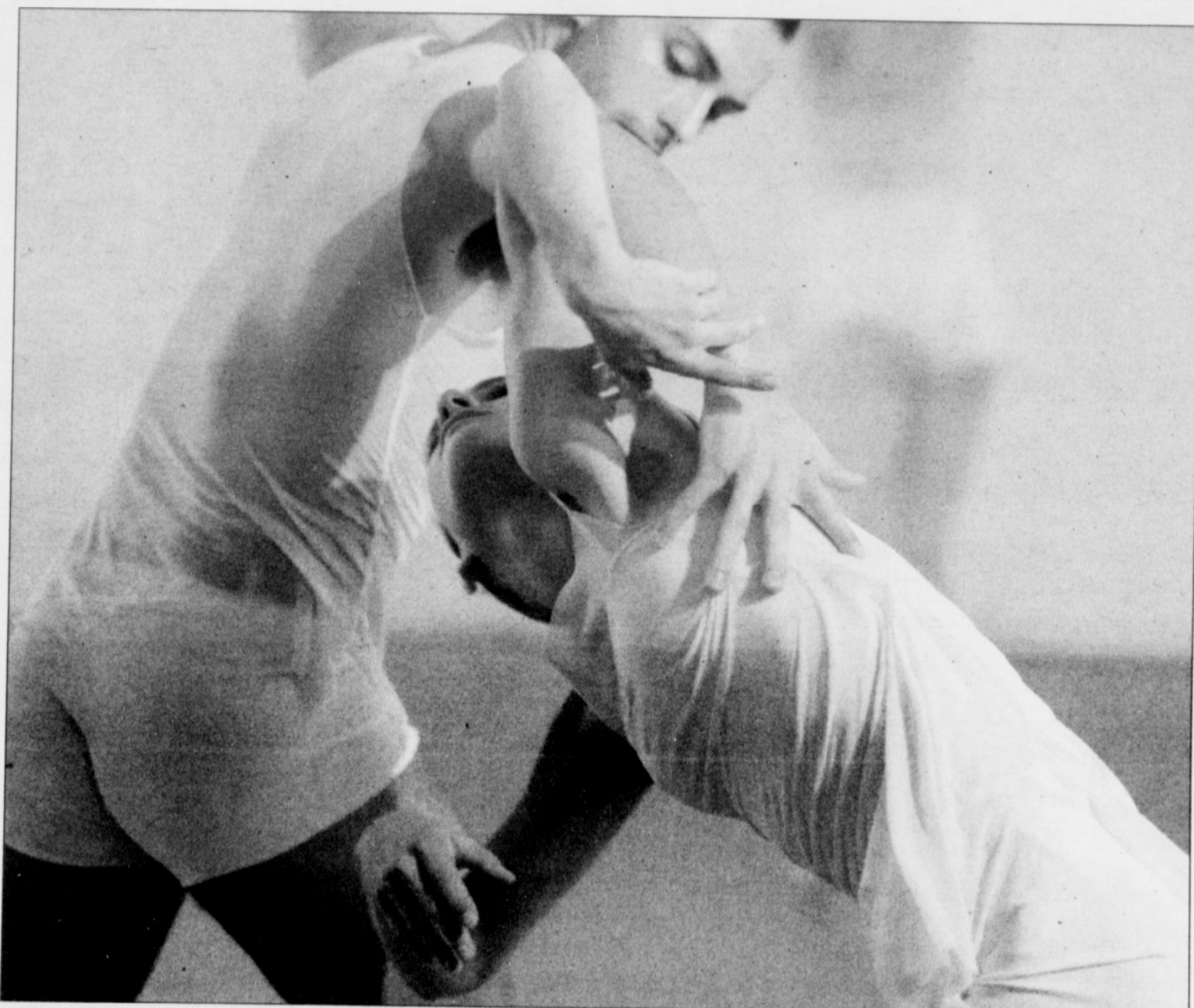

NAACP Honors Music Icon

Media impresario and humanitarian Quincy Jones has been selected as the 99th recipient of the NAACP's Spingarn Medal, the civil rights group's highest honor.

Awarded for outstanding and noble achievement by an American of African descent, the medal will be bestowed on July 23 at 105th NAACP National Convention in Las Vegas.

Jones is also a respected humanitarian. In 1985, he pioneered the model of using celebrity to raise money and awareness for a cause with "We Are the World."

The song remains the best-selling single of all-time, and raised more than \$63 Million for Ethiopian famine relief.

"Quincy Jones is an icon of the entertainment industry who has shaped the lives of millions through music, film, and more," stated NAACP Chairman Roslyn M. Brock. "But what makes Mr. Jones so deserving of this award is how he uses his celebrity and influence to advance critical humanitarian issues across the globe. We are honored to count him among our prestigious Spingarn medalists."
