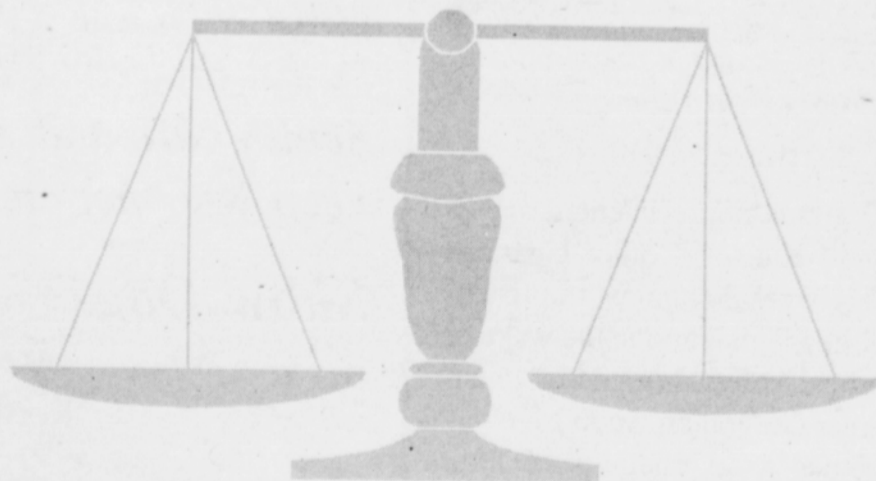

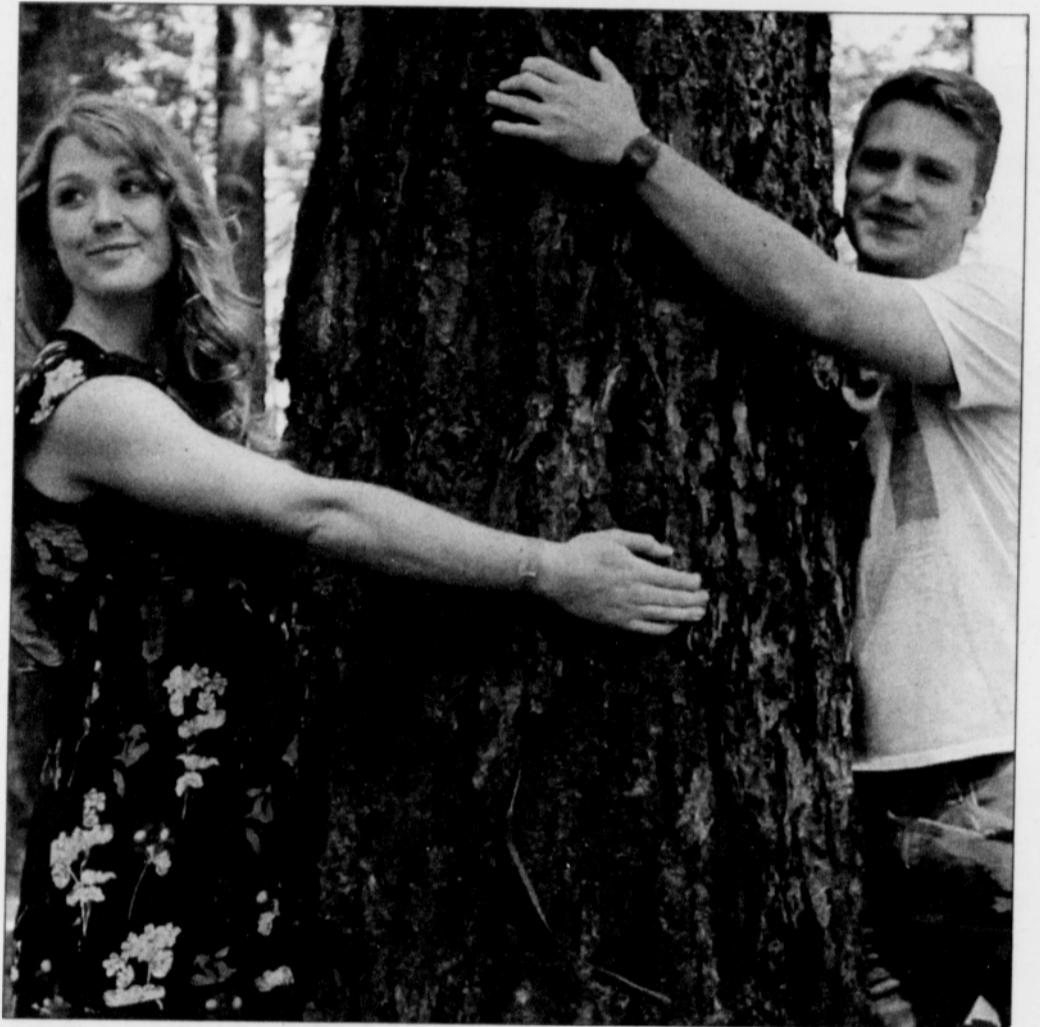

Folks will gather at Hoyt Arboretum on Saturday, July 12 to defend a Guinness World Record for the most people simultaneously hugging trees.

## Largest Tree Hug Challenge

On Saturday, July 12, Oregon attempted to best Portland's pride and world renown is at stake as tree huggers from around the northwest will gather at Hoyt Arboretum from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. to defend the Guinness World Record for the world's largest tree hug.

Portland tree huggers set a new world record last year with 936 people simultaneously hugging trees for one minute at Hoyt Arboretum; however, tree hugging challengers have already

attempted to best Portland's record, most recently in Nepal and Scotland.

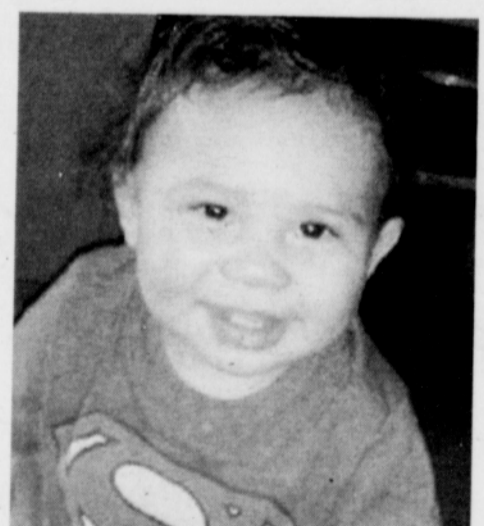
The new attempt will take place in the arboretum near Southwest Kingston and Knight Boulevards. The event is free and open to the public of all ages.
