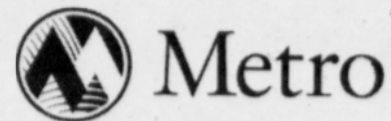

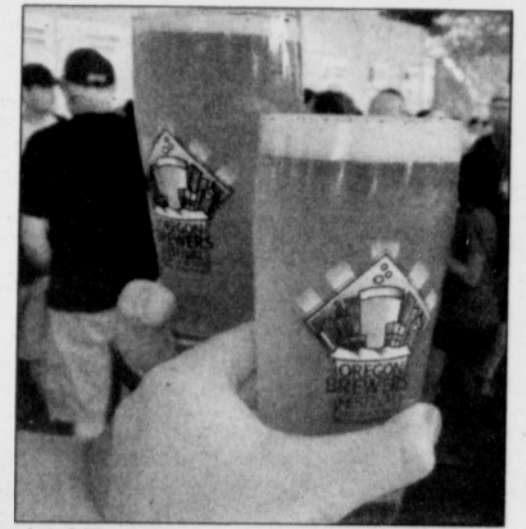

At 27 years running, the Oregon Brewers Festival is one of the oldest and best-loved craft beer festivals in the world.

Crown Jewel of Beer Festivals

Over the next five days, craft breweries from all parts of the nation will serve more than 30 beer styles to at thousands of beer lovers from around the world. The Oregon Brewers Festival opens Wednesday and runs through Sunday, July 27 at Tom McCall Waterfront Park, downtown.

The event was founded in 1988 by Art Larrance, co-founder of Portland Brewing Co.; Dick and Nancy Ponzi of BridgePort Brewing Co.; and Kurt and Rob Widmer of Widmer Bros. Brewing Co. Along with McMenamins, these were the only microbreweries in Portland at the time, and there were just three more across the state.

Today, there are 173 brewing companies operating 214 brewing facilities in 70 cities in Oregon. Portland alone has 56 breweries—more than any other city in the world.

Admission into the festival grounds is free. In order to consume beer, purchase of a 2014 souvenir tasting glass is required and costs \$7. Beer is purchased with wooden tokens, which cost \$1 apiece. Patrons pay four tokens for a full 12.8oz glass of beer, or one token for a 3oz. taste.

Dance Demos and a Movie

All ages are welcome to attend a National Dance Day celebration on Saturday, July 26 at Risley Park in Oak Grove.

The North Clackamas Parks and Recreation event is free to attend and is open to the public. You can watch or try out a few new dance moves taught by instructors. The dance classes start at 6:30 p.m. and cover Zumba, line dancing, hula, little dancers and tiny tots.

After the dance demos, the movie *Despicable Me* will be shown.
