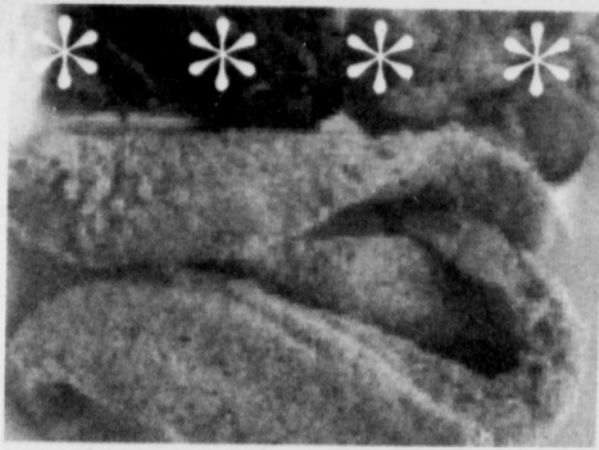

Ross is a trans black woman from Chicago whose mission is to spread a message to all people, transgender and cisgender (non-transgender) alike that their lives and the journey of their lives are uniquely sacred and valuable. Transgender people of color often times live at the margins of multiple communities, experiencing higher rates of poverty, HIV, and discrimination than their white or cisgender peers.
