Recruiting Women in Math and Science

Oregon State University has been awarded a \$3.5 million grant from the National Science Foundation to improve conditions for women in the academic science, technology, engineering and math, or STEM, disciplines.

The financial support will be used to help recruit, retain and promote more women in STEM and the social and behavioral sciences at OSU; provide support

for women in STEM and implement policies and programs that aid in these efforts.

Women have historically been underrepresented in the STEM fields—in academia. OSU leaders have taken significant steps to enhance diversity on campus in recent years, and the science foundation is

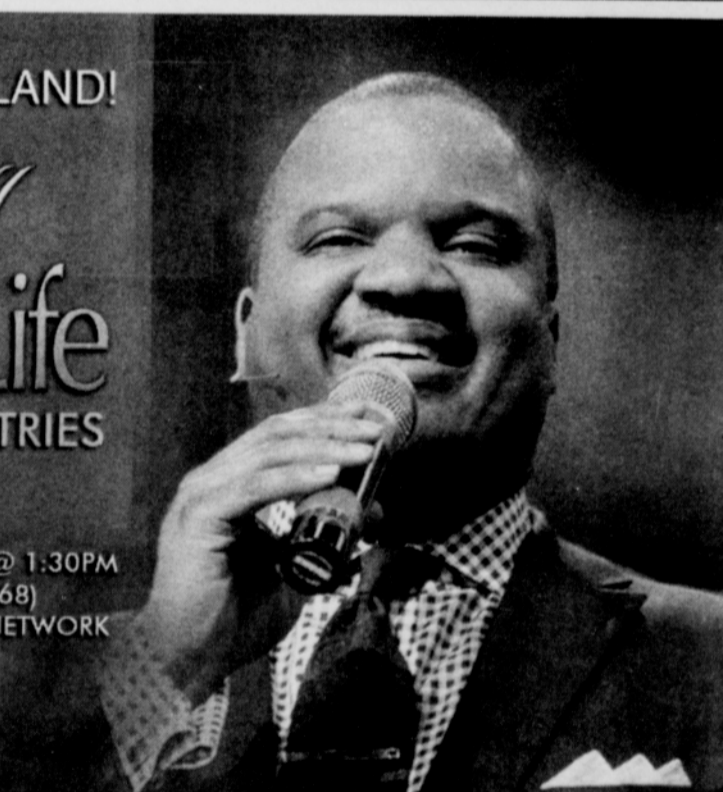
