Neil Kelly Street Fair

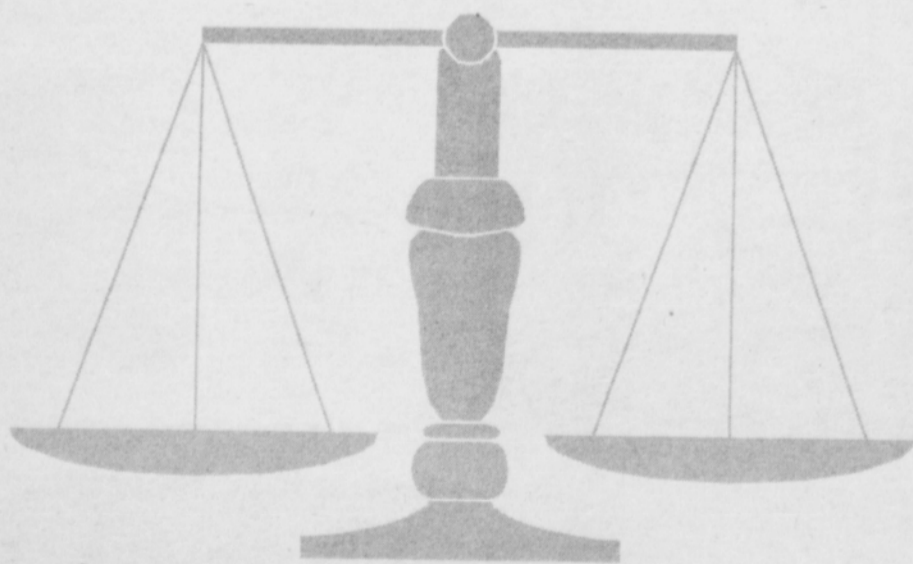

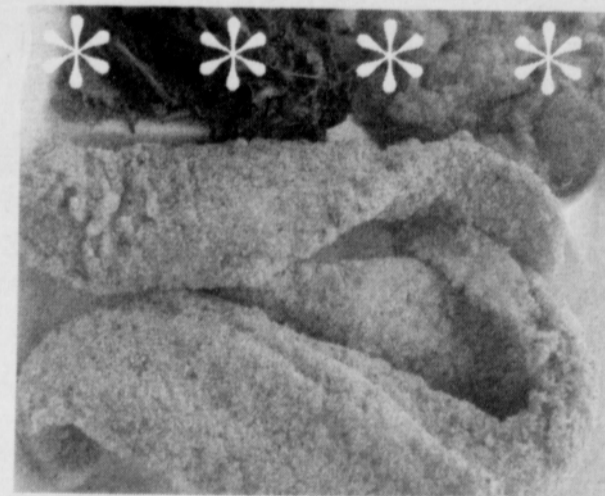
