Latino Theater's Hip Hop Performance

'Dreamscape' tackles issues of police brutality and racial profiling

Portland's Milagro Theatre presents the powerful hip-hop theatre production *Dreamscape*, based on the real shooting of Tyisha Miller an African-American teenager in southern California, shot by the police on 1998.

Using details from Miller's autopsy and reflections of her life, the play explores the relations and consequences of the systemic racism, police brutality and racial profiling impacting minorities and communities of color in modern America.

Through Beatboxing, spoken word, and dance, this performance

depicts the inner life of a young woman who dreams though the impact of the 12 bullets that kill her. A powerfully clear-eyed look at the relationships between race, the body, and violence as woman reminisces about her life, describing the pleasures of softball, dancing, kissing, and hair styling with sweetness, humor, and all the insight of a 19-year-old.

Dreamscape presents an opportunity to talk about the realities of police violence and race crimes on stage and every night after the show with post-show conversations with the play's creator, playwright Rickerby Hinds, a professor in the School of Theater, Film and Television at the University of California.

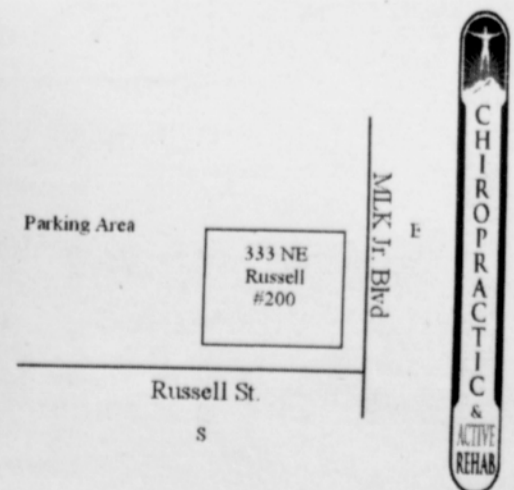
