the resident select the right tree for their space, or in some cases helps a landlord select the best tree for his apartment building or complex.

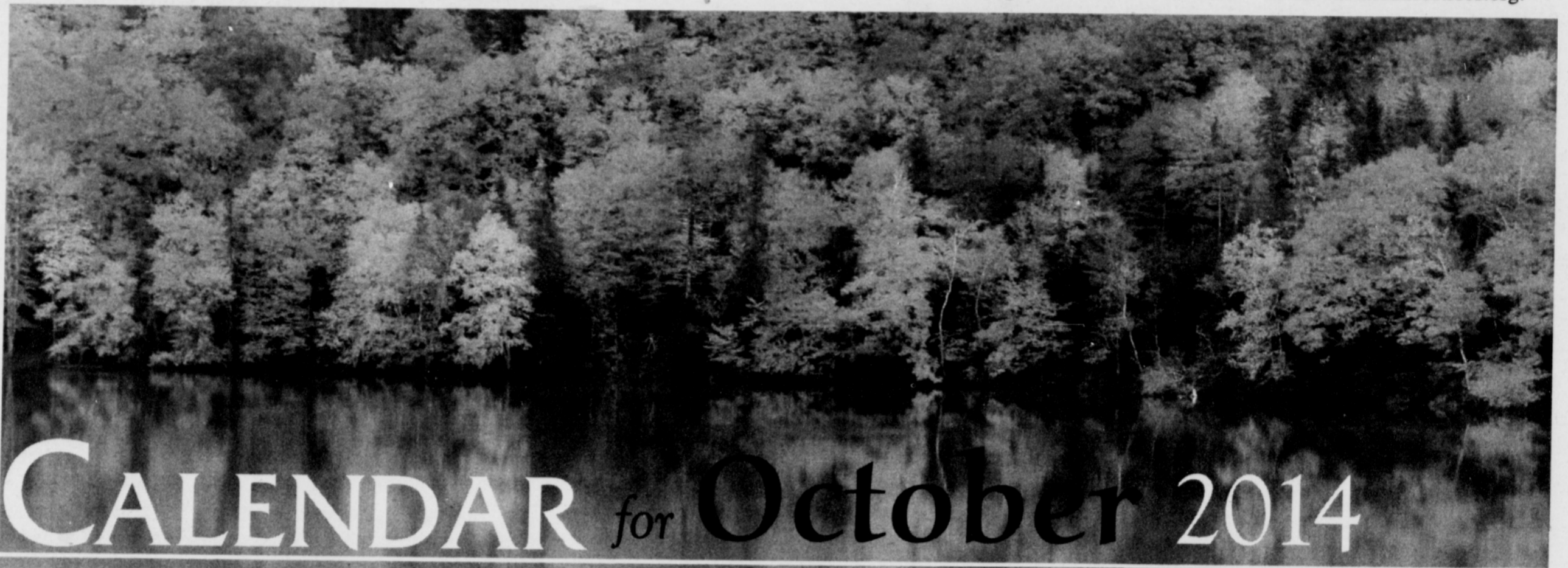
Bedell-Stiles encourages people to call in and ask for a tree inspector visit. She says the \$25 tree offer is

particularly great when you consider that trees can cost up to \$200 at a nursery.
