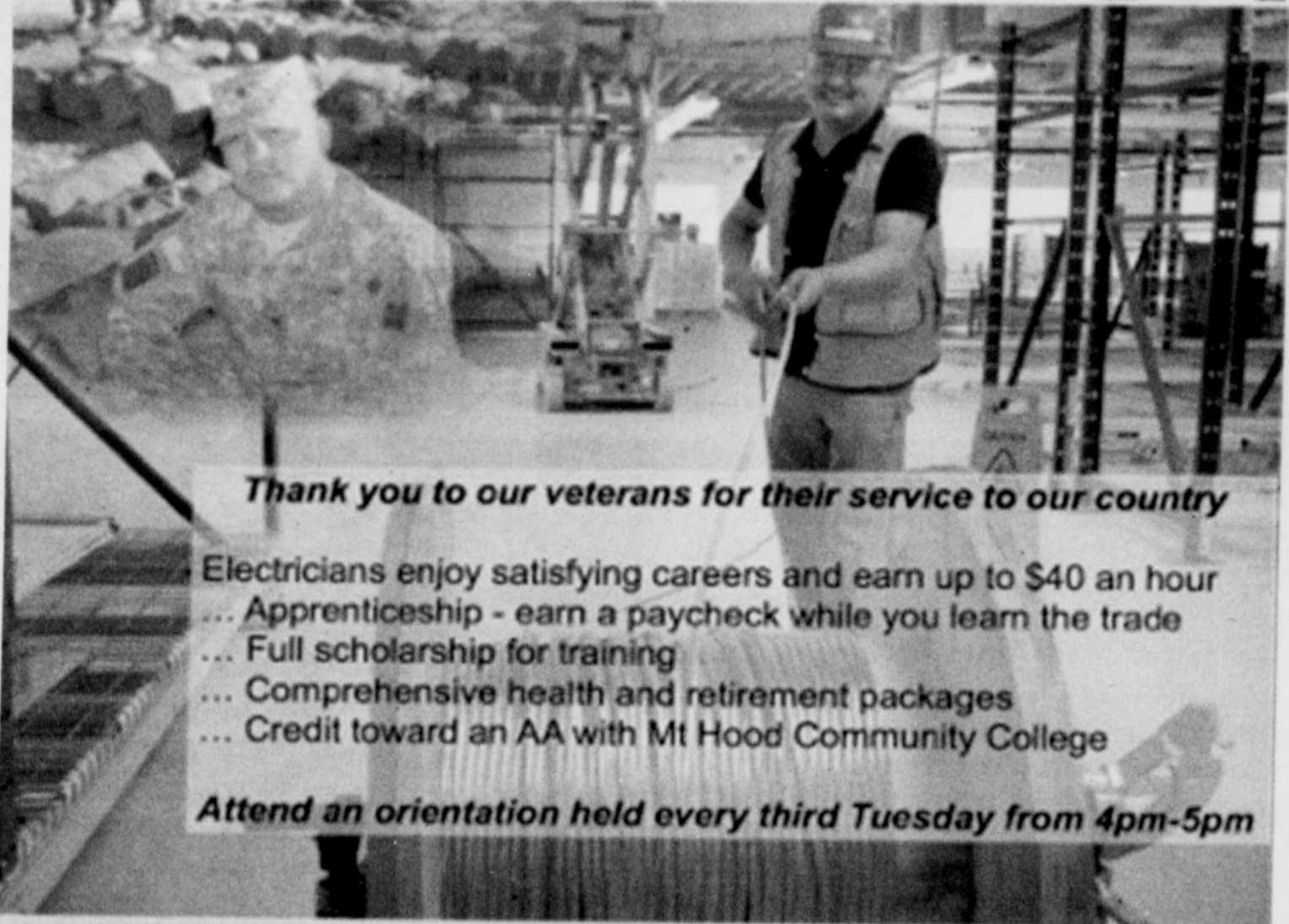

Winds, Cold Throw Punch

High winds hit the Portland metro area causing major power outages Tuesday with a high wind warning issued through Wednesday and a chance of winter precipitation falling in valley locations in and near the Columbia River Gorge on Thursday.

Attorney General Nominee

In a second trail-blazing pick for the nation's top law enforcement officer, President Barack Obama Saturday nominated a federal prosecutor in New York to become the next attorney general and the first black woman to lead the Justice Department. If confirmed by the Senate, Loretta Lynch would replace Eric Holder, who served as the nation's first black attorney general.
