Shay James, senior director for the Franklin High School cluster has been promoted to senior director of College and Career Readiness for Portland Public Schools.

Assistant Superintendent Antonio Lopez said James will oversee the district's goal of getting all students to graduation prepared for college and career.

James served as Franklin High School principal for six years and vice principal for two. During her time at Franklin, the school dramatically increased access for historically under-served students to Advanced Placement courses and closed the achievement gap in its graduation rate between white, African American, and Latino students.

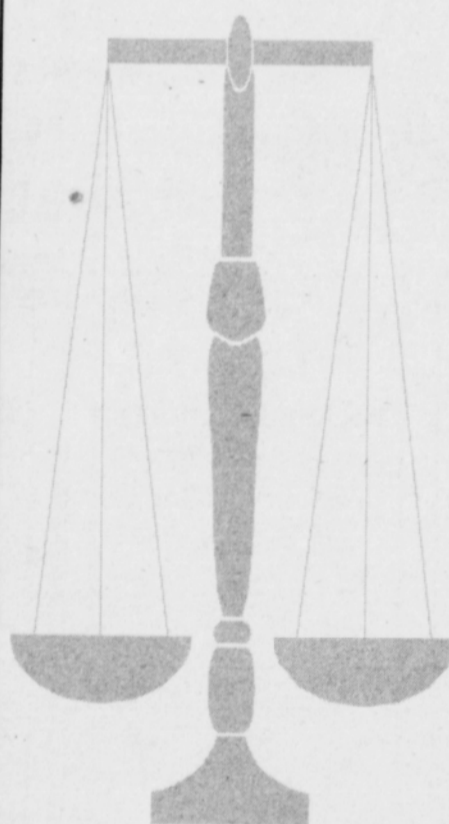
The 2014-2015 Fix-It Fair dates
