Culture Survives War Internment

Japanese American history comes to life when the Oregon Nikkei Endowment presents the Portland debut of "Hidden Legacy: Japanese Traditional Arts in the World War II

Internment Camps." The screening takes place Sunday, Nov. 30 at 2 p.m. at the historic Hollywood Theatre in northeast Portland.

The documentary is the first ever major presentation of traditional music, dance, and drama in the World War II internment camps. Through historical footage and interviews with the artists, "Hidden Legacy" tells the story of how the cultural

arts were maintained by the remarkable teachers during their internment.

This one-time only event will include a live musical concert with master koto player Shirley Kazuyo Muramoto-Wong along with traditional Japanese music and folk dance performances by Portland-based troupe, Sahomi Tachibana Dancers.

The documentary 'Broken Heart Land' follows the story of Zack Harrington, a gay teenager who finds himself HIV-positive and struggling with the heartbreaking intolerance of his conservative upbringing. An exclusive showing of the film takes place at the Clinton Street Theater, Saturday, Nov. 29 to Thursday, Dec. 4.

Heartbreaking Intolerance

When a gay teenager growing up in America's Bible belt finds himself HIV-positive, he decides to take his own life instead.

"Broken Heart Land" follows the story of the young man, Zack, and how his grief-stricken parents process his suicide.

Against the backdrop of a small, isolated town divided on the issue of homosexuality, Zack's grief-stricken parents, both conservative Republicans and military veterans

are left to reconcile their own social and political beliefs.

The film has won praise for the way it addresses critical issues of HIV/AIDS awareness, the lack of comprehensive sex education and LGBT rights where these issues are considered taboo.

The documentary is set for an exclusive run at the Clinton Street Theater in southeast Portland from Saturday, Nov. 29 to Thursday, Dec. 4.
