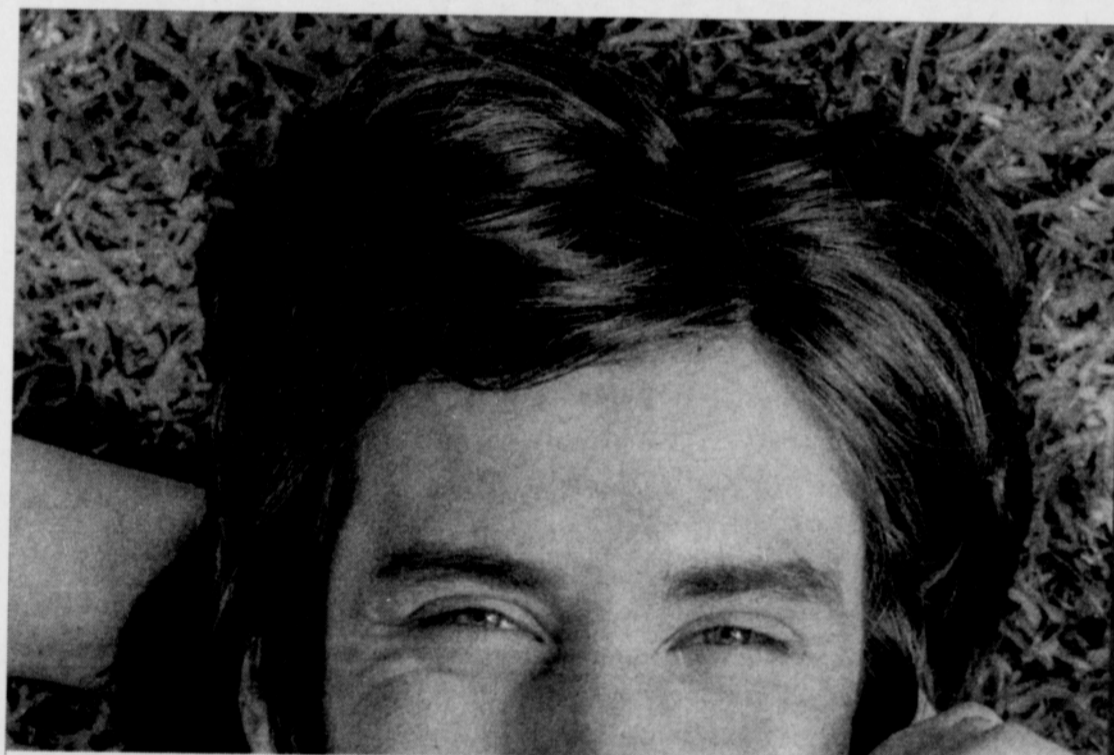




## Community Support for Oregon Non-Profits

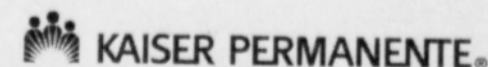
