Shooting Brings Terror to Reynolds High School

June 11 — Two sisters embrace from the safety of a nearby parking lot after a shooter with a rifle canvassed the halls of Reynolds High School east of Portland, killing a student and wounding a teacher before killing himself. More than 100 law enforcement officers, tactical teams and medical staff rushed to the school and helped all inside.



Beloved Entertainer Remembered

June 4 — Portland jazz, blues and gospel fans mourn the loss of one of the city's most beloved entertainers. Janice Scroggins died May 27 at the age of 58. She was an Oregon Music Hall of Fame Inductee. She began playing piano at 3-years-old and came from a family of church musicians. In 2000, she was nominated for a Grammy for her album "Janice Scroggins Plays Scott Joplin."

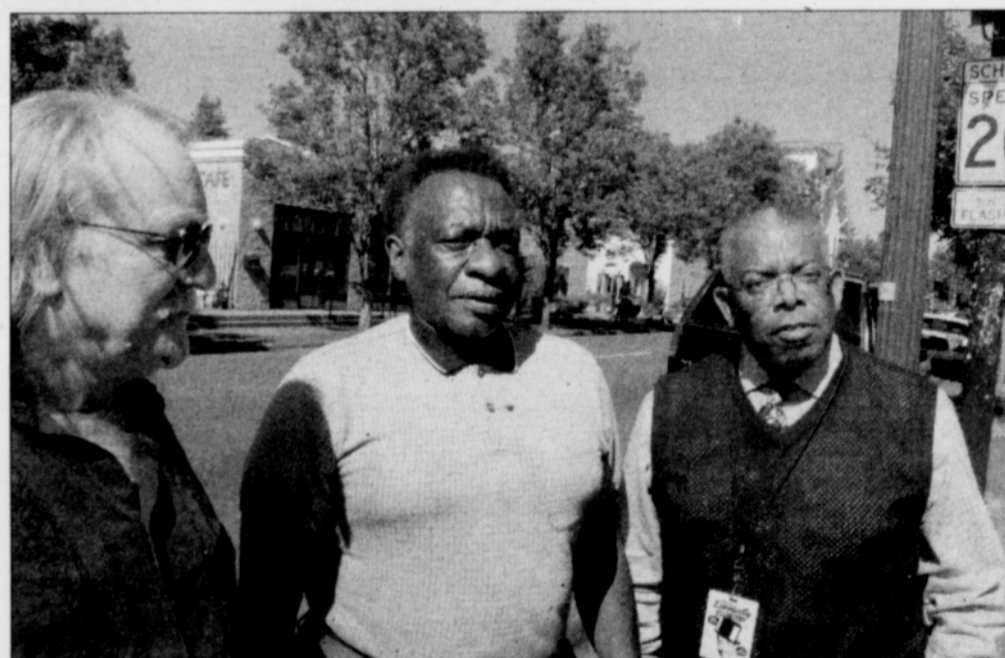


Move Over for Luxury

June 18 — A new trend puts more fuel on the gentrification of local neighborhoods as older housing stock gets leveled for higher-costing living. Records from recent real estate transactions in some relatively low and medium income neighborhoods of north and northeast Portland are being demolished and replaced with new and often much larger, more expensive homes.

Revisiting Alberta

June 25 — Two longtime Portland educators look to resurrect a student-led study on the heavily gentrified neighborhoods around Northeast Alberta Street. Bob Zyback and Mike Grice are recreating a project to tackle issues like gentrification and gang violence, but also the "Last Thursday" monthly arts walk that spills crowds, noise and parked vehicles into adjoining residential properties.



George Fox Backs Down

July 30 — Jayce Marcus, a transgender student from Portland attending George Fox University in Newberg, wins the right to be housed with other male students on campus. However written into the school's new policies are requirements that future transgender students, especially transgender students of color, may struggle to meet.



Globalization Impact

Aug. 6 — Portland photographer Alex Riedlinder tackles issues of globalization relating to Africa and America to produce a photo-documentary on life in Nigeria, using scenes that he captured during a recent visit. His work adds alternative narratives around black people in America.
