Exploring the Human Condition

'Hyde' is a new piece of dance and theater that explores our attraction to the dark side of our internal struggles, while posing the question-how do we move beyond our multiplicities?

Abstracted from the iconic tale of Jekyll and Hyde, the production coming to Xomtopia, 810 S.E. Belmont St., for two weekends, is tender, funny, alarming and compelling.

"Hyde" uses the language of the body in tandem with sound, vocalization, costume and video projection to create a recognizable and visceral piece about the human experience. The show is supported by a project grant from the Regional Arts Council and is partnering with p:ear to create continued support for art programs for at-risk youth.
