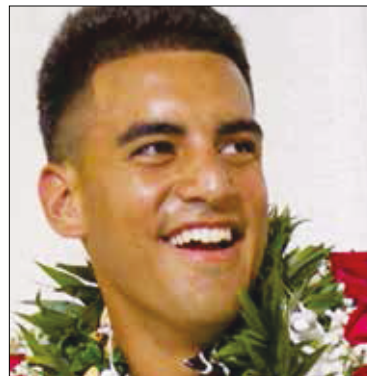

Drafted No. 2 by Tennessee

(AP) — The Tennessee Titans hope they got it right this time with Oregon's Marcus Mariota, their third try at landing a franchise quarterback in the past decade.

The Titans selected the Heisman Trophy winner No. 2 overall pick Thursday night after starting three quarterbacks last season.

General manager Ruston Webster said other teams offered "multiple" picks to move up to the No.

2 spot, though the Titans refused to budge, believing they drafted the quarterback that can turn around a team that went 2-14 in 2014.

Mariota could start the season opener Sept. 13 at Tampa Bay against the top pick, Jameis Winston. Neither was at the NFL draft in Chicago on Thursday — Mariota, from Hawaii was in Honolulu with nearly 300 family and friends; Winston was in his hometown of Bessemer, Ala.
