from Open Meadow, an alternative high school which has since moved. It will be opened to the public, and provide access to 477 households not currently served by another park within a half mile, parks officials announced Tuesday.

The City Council approved the \$880,000 purchase and the deal was completed on May 29. Parks System Development Charges, the one-time fees assessed on new development, will cover the costs.

The property is now open for public use for picnics, reading, relaxing and other passive activities. A process for formally naming the park will take place once the site has a Master Plan, officials said.

"The St. John's Community has experienced considerable residential growth over the past few years," notes Portland Parks Commissioner Amanda Fritz. "The opportunity to purchase the N Crawford St and N Polk Ave property with Parks System Development Charge revenue provided a way to increase the parkland in the area to help mitigate the impact of that growth."

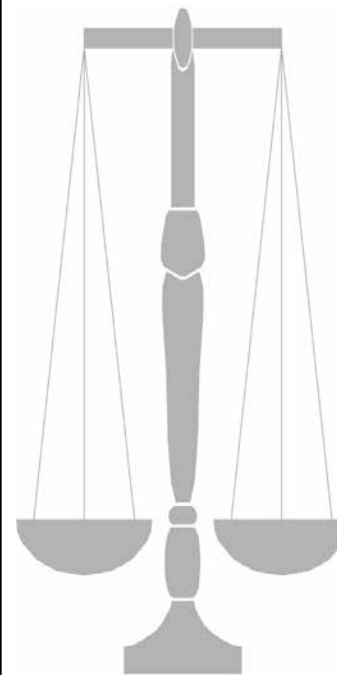
