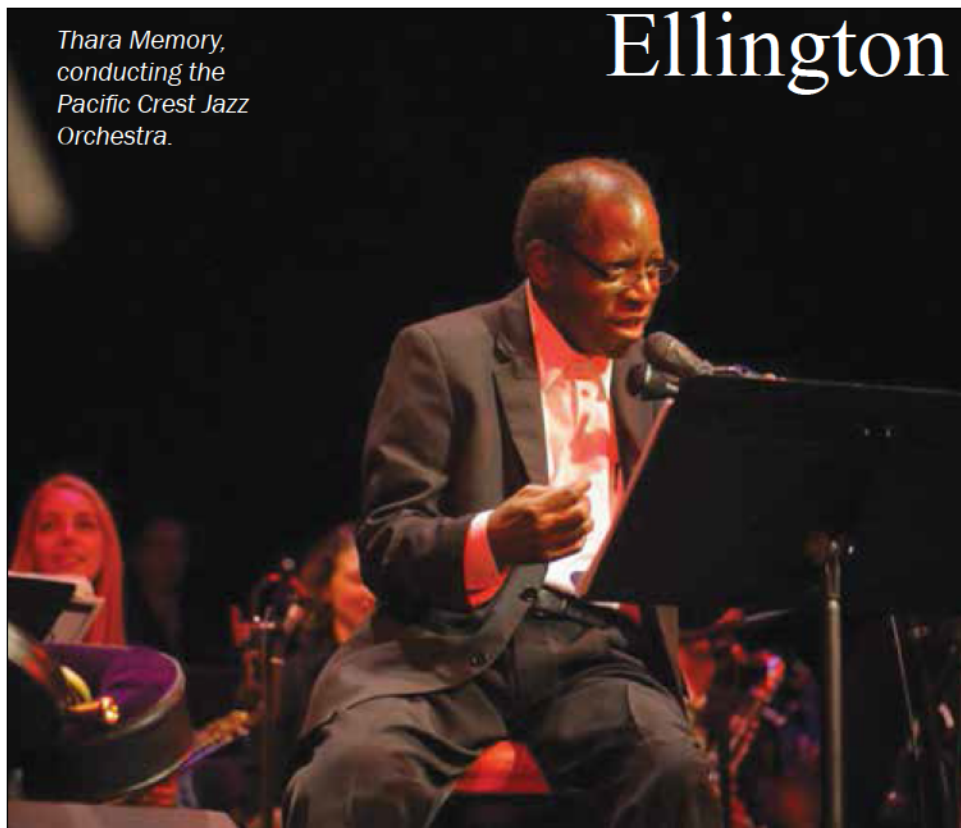
Ellington Winner Encore
