Youth from a culturally diverse performing arts program get into the real-life consequences and cases surrounding racial tension, gentrification, and other painful coming of age issues in an encore performance of their new show, Between the Lines. The performance follows the life of a sharp, young student, Zara Smith, as she struggles to walk the line between two worlds – between her culture and her dreams, between academic success and her own background.
