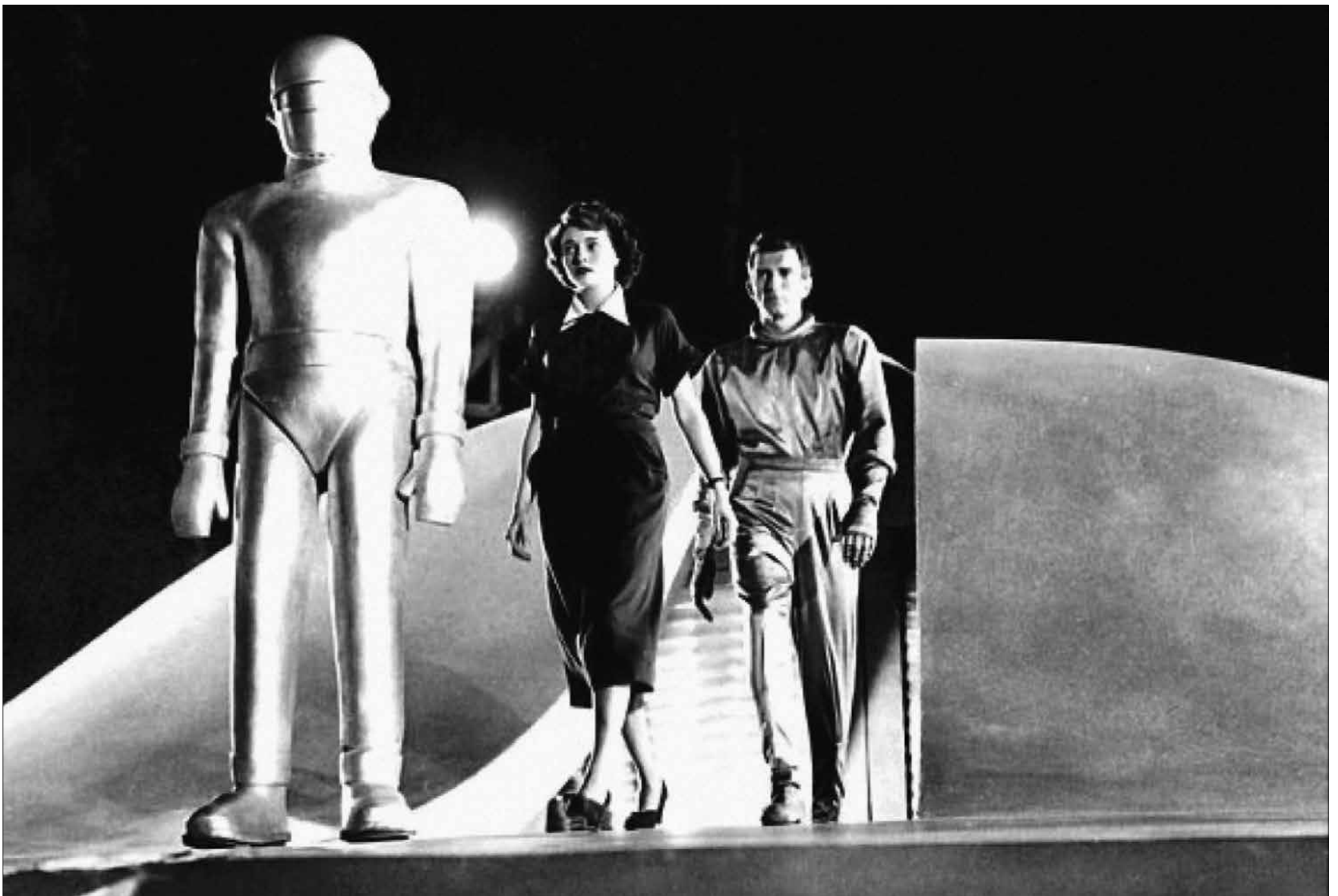

The movie series kicks off Thursday, Aug. 13 with "The Day the Earth Stood Still," followed by "Ghostbusters" on Friday, Aug. 14; "American Graffiti" on Saturday, Aug. 15; "Young Frankenstein" on Thursday, Aug. 20; "Poltergeist" on Friday, Aug. 21; and "Star Trek II – Wrath of Khan" on Saturday, Aug.
