street festivals, drawing more than 25,000 people each year.

This year festival includes 300 vendors, 3 stages of music, and 2 beer gardens. The events are kicked off by the Kids Parade on Saturday, which welcomes children of all ages to dawn costumes

and musical instruments to meet up at 10:30 a.m. at the Alberta Co-op's parking lot on the corner of Alberta and Northeast 15th Avenue.
