The People’s Co-op and Portland’s Know Your City are proud to host an important discussion on food justice and the civil rights movement this Martin Luther King Jr. holiday.


Martin Luther King Jr. worked with a coalition of leaders on a broad range of issues, including a food crisis that impacts low income communities and people of color today. Access to affordable, healthy food is central to our public health crisis, and this issue is clearly exacerbated by racism and class discrimination.
