
Tiger Woods cited for DUI

Part 5. WHIPLASH: It doesn't take a serious accident to cause serious damage.

How bad an accident does it take to actually cause whiplash?

: While most people think of whiplash only as the result of a rear end collision, it can occur as a result of a fall or other sudden jolt. In car collisions, speeds as low as 5 MPH (a brisk walk) have caused whiplash. What's more, major studies show there is virtually no correlation between damage to the car and its occupants.

How can I tell if whiplash has happened to me?

Whiplash often exhibits symptoms such as a sore neck, arm or shoulder, nausea, blurred vision and headaches. If not treated immediately, these problems can lead to other more severe ones. To complicate matters, it sometimes takes years before whiplash symptoms occur.
