Sylvester grew up in Bonita, Louisiana, hearing BB King on the juke boxes as well as other Blues legends.. After moving to Portland, he learned to play guitar from his high school buddy Isaac Scott. Though Sylvester first played Gospel, Soul, Funk as well as the Blues, he realized over 32 years ago that he was destined to \$12 at the door.

> After playing the first Waterfront Blues (then Rose City) Festival in 1987, BB's manager called them to open for BB King at Arlene Schnitzer Concert Hall. That show really launched the band into a period of great success that continues to this day. They opened again for him when possible after that.

> When the Blues men were together, BB referred to Sylvester as his "Birthday Brother." They were born on the same day, 20 years


