thousands of burial goods, the golden coffins and shrines, the masks, the jewellery and the fate of the king who died young has remained unbroken.

The exhibition leads you right to the heart of Tutankhamun's tomb, presents his treasures and explains them in context allowing people the

chance to relive what the British archaeologist Howard Carter went through in November 1922."

Tickets to "The Discovery of King Tut," which include general museum admission, are \$22 for adults, \$15 for youth (ages 3-13), and \$18 for seniors (ages 63+). Guests can purchase tickets online at omsi.edu, via phone at 503-797-4000 or in person at the museum.
