2019 Chevrolet Equinox



The 2019 Chevrolet Equinox has a lot of options making it a good choice when considering a vehicle with good fuel economy and a standard price of \$35,000.

The Equinox comes with a 1.5 liter turbo, 4-cycle engine or premier 2.0 liter turbocharged engine. Fuel efficiency is rated at 24 mpg. The car's direct Injection and stop/start technology is paired with a 9-speed automatic transmission

and Chevrolet's infotainment system is included.

Driver safety features include lane change and blind zone alerts. A keyless feature locks and unlocks the vehicle's doors without having to use the key fob, increas-

ing security and convenience.

The Equinox also comes with cruise control and remote start so you can step into a comfortably warmed or cooled vehicle, depending on the weather and your preset preferences.
