The menu includes ham, Au Gratin potatoes, candied yams, green beans, hot dinner rolls with butter, fruit salad, pie, hot coffee and apple cider. Guests also receive a gift bag to include a hat, gloves and hand warmers.

"We want our guests to feel cared for, respected and loved on this special day," says Lori Quinney, food service director.
