## Digital Displays Come to Transit Stops

TriMet buses also accept cash again

TriMet is bringing new electronic digital information displays to bus stops and transit centers served by multiple bus lines and used by a large number of riders. The new technology comes as the transit agency accepts cash fares on buses once again.

TriMet suspended cash fares on March 26 for the safety of bus operators and riders to limit the time they are close to each other while boarding the bus during the COVID-19 pandemic. Now that the transit system
