This include hazardous materials abatement related to 2017 Bond funded projects as well as on an ad hoc basis for Portland Community College projects District Wide. PCC intends to enter into a Pricing Agreement with one or more Asbestos Contractors.

The scope of work includes Materials Abatement on an as-needed basis for projects on PCC properties (including campuses, centers, farms, and residences with work areas above and below ground) within the Portland Metropolitan area.

This may include both planned and emergency projects encompassing containment, encapsulation, decontamination, mitigation, removal, transportation, disposal, demolition, stabilization and associated services for asbestos-containing materials (ACM), lead or lead-based paint materials, mold, silica, polychlorinated biphenyl (PCB), mercury, or other hazardous materials as necessary to accommodate PCC projects.
