Neighbor suspected in protest shooting

A 43-year-old neighbor man is suspected of fatally shooting a woman protester on Saturday night at Normandale Park in the Rose City neighborhood following a confrontation between him

and other anti-police protesters, authorities said Tuesday.

In a statement, the Portland Police Bureau identified the suspect
