PPB Training Vehicles Burned

On Thursday, May 2, 1014 at 1:55a.m., Portland Police North Precinct was dispatched to assist Portland Fire & Rescue at the Portland Police Training Division, located in the 14900 block of Northeast Airport Way. When they arrived they found at least 15 vehicles in a fenced training area were burning. Firefighters extinguished the fires. The building was undamaged, and no injuries were reported.

Lloyd Neighborhood Homicide Investigation

On Sunday, May 5th, 2024 at approximately 4:10 a.m., officers from the North Precinct responded to the 300 block of NE Weidler Street on a report of a shooting. Officers arrived on scene and located a deceased adult male. No suspect or suspects were immediately located.

New Learning and Innovation Center

Replacement Ballots Sent

Multnomah County Elections is replacing ballots for up to 9,300 voters, parts of three precincts in East County, and 1.6% of all registered voters as their original ballots omitted Measure 26-244. Elections learned of the omission May 2. Affected voters received a version of the ballot designed for people who live outside Metro's jurisdictional boundaries. New ballots for those voters were placed in the mail starting May 2. Most of the voters, are in two precincts in Gresham, with the

remainder just south of the city. Affected voters will also receive a letter with their new ballot explaining what to do if they've already received their original ballot and how to process their replacement ballot. Elections staff are available to speak with anyone affected at 503-988-VOTE.

Arrests Made at PSU

Arrests made at PSU's library after trespassers illegally entered the building again despite efforts to secure it. On May 2, Portland Police Officers made a total of 30 arrests, which included at least 6 Portland State students. Portland State University Officers put one individual on a police mental health hold and arrested one other person. Portland Police are continuing to investigate crimes committed in the library and will continue to make arrests when appropriate and forward cases to the Multnomah County District Attorney for prosecution.
