Several men, including Devine, who were directly connected with the contest, were placed under arrest, but the testimony presented at the Magistrate's hearing today (Devine Flanagan's death) was positive on the part of all the witnesses that no blow had been struck immediately preceding the fatal collapse of the pugilist.
