VERY CHEAP FARE.

Chautauqua Association Makes Arrangements With Southern Pacific.

The Chautauqua Association has made an arrangement with the Southern Pacific whereby a round trip ticket to Gladstone Park can be purchased for 5c. This ticket entitles the holder, in addition to his railroad fare, to a round trip ride from any point in the city on the lines of the City & Suburban Railway Company, which connects with the Southern Pacific on East Washington street. In other words, a person purchasing a 5c ticket can ride from his home to the train, go out to Gladstone Park, secure admission there, ride back on the train, and from the depot to his home on the street car. This is the only arrangement for transportation which the Chautauqua Association has entered into, and persons going to the park by any other mode of conveyance will have to walk three-quarters of a mile.

GENERAL T. J. MORGAN HERE

Noted Chautauqua Orator Will Speak at Gladstone Park.

General Thomas J. Morgan, of New York, is registered at the Imperial. General Morgan comes to Oregon to speak at the Chautauqua Association, which opens its Summer sessions at Gladstone Park next Monday. Among other addresses General Morgan will deliver the Fourth of July oration on the association grounds. Throughout the administration of President Harrison General Morgan was Commissioner of Indian Affairs, and gained considerable distinction by his opposition to the support of sectarian schools by the Government. He was an officer of the Civil War, and is a member of the Grand Army of the Republic. He is a familiar orator at Chautauqua Associations throughout the country.
