

GENERAL SIGEL'S FUNERAL

Services Will be Held at a New York Turn Verein Hall Today. NEW YORK, Aug. 23.—The funeral services for the body of General Sigel will be held Sunday afternoon at the hall of the Turn Verein, this city, where the body will lie in state from 10 A. M. until 1 P. M. The services will be conducted under the direction of G. A. F. G. A. R. George Vansick, of the State Zeitung, delivering a eulogy in German. A eulogy in English will also be delivered by a speaker yet to be selected. The body will be taken to Woodlawn cemetery for interment. There will be a large attendance of representatives from the various Turn Vereins of which the dead General was an honorary member. The pallbearers will be Germans who fought under Sigel in the revolution of 1848.

The surviving members of a committee appointed 23 years ago by the English New Jersey Regiment Association to draft resolutions on the death of General Hooker just held a meeting in New York, N. J. The committee's report on the death of General Sigel, the earlier meeting was pursuant to a resolution adopted in the case of General Hooker's death, to fulfill a duty the performance of which the New Jersey soldiers who had fought under Hooker in the Third Army Corps and Eighth Army Corps had solemnly pledged themselves. In 1879, just prior to his death, General Hooker was present at a reunion of the Eighth Regiment Association in this city, and along with General Sigel was an honored guest. It was at this banquet that General Hooker, foreseeing his death, suggested that a committee be appointed to take such action as might be deemed proper by the association. In accordance with General Hooker's request, the association appointed a committee to which was added the names of General Sigel and General Sigel accepted the duty and submitted a set of resolutions, which were adopted as the sentiment of the Eighth Regiment Association.

The original copy of these resolutions is now in the hands of Mr. Connolly, and was read at the meeting just held, and adopted. General Sigel's name displacing that of General Hooker, there are only three survivors of this committee.
