NO GOLD COIN IN VAULTS. United States Treasury Reports an Unparalleled Condition.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 30.—For the first time since the Treasury finds itself without any gold coin in its vaults, it is explained that this condition is the result of an unprecedented demand for gold certificates during the time when the mints have been fully employed in coining Philippine silver and subsidiary silver for the United States.

The Secretary has given instructions to the mints at Philadelphia and San Francisco to begin the coining of double eagles on February 1, and to work overtime until a sufficient supply has been coined to meet all demands.

All Knowledge of the Alleged Mediation Proposed by Prince Ching at Peking is Specifically Denied at St. Petersburg.

ST. PETERSBURG, Jan. 30.—"It will be astonishing if Japan remains inflexible," were the significant words of an official of the Foreign Office to the Associated Press this afternoon in speaking of the Russian response to the Japanese proposal, which will be dispatched to Tokyo next week.

All knowledge of the alleged mediation proposed by Prince Ching at Peking is specifically denied at St. Petersburg.

The report that 100 Russian troops are to occupy Antung is also contradicted, it being intimated that as this is one of the open ports of the United States, the report might have been put out to arouse a feeling of hostile feeling in the United States.
