

OCEAN BAYS FLOUR

But Purchases Are Not for Immediate Delivery.

RUSH WILL COME LATER

Hop Crop Prospects in New York State—Four Cars of Over-Ripe Bananas Arrive—Collection of Duties at Fair.

FLOUR—Oriental are buying for later delivery. HOPS—Hop crop prospects in New York State. FRUIT—Four cars of over-ripe bananas arrive. POTATOES—Oregon in good demand. First new crops on hand. POULTRY—Some stock is carried over. EGGS—Good inquiry for fresh stock. BUTTER—Firm and active.

The prospects for export flour business are much brighter. While but very little is doing for immediate shipment, the Japanese have begun to buy quite liberally for shipment in the latter part of September, and in October. They evidently expect lower prices on the new crop, and have been waiting for it. The latest advice from Japan are that the rice crop will not be good, and this is likely to help the flour market. Stocks at the Japanese ports at present are large, and the late buying has been merely to replenish them.

Trade with Hongkong is very slow at the moment, but is expected to revive shortly. Flour stocks are small there, the latest advice reporting 90,000 sacks of California and 300,000 sacks of Oregon and Washington flour on hand. Sales in the preceding fortnight were only 14,000 sacks.

An intimation has been given shippers by the Hawaiian Company that it will provide an extra steamer during the flour rush. If it does, there will be no need of pressing tramp vessels into service, but if the company fails to provide the facilities, the shippers will certainly put on independent steamers. Bookings are now being made for four space on the China liner sailing in the latter part of September, but there is plenty of room on the steamer leaving September 2, as well as on the vessel scheduled to sail on the 10th inst.

NEW YORK HOP CROP.

Mail Advices Confirm Reports of Unsettled Conditions. Mail advices received yesterday from New York confirm telegraphic reports received a few days ago of conditions in the hop harvest of that state. A letter from a New York dealer and grower said:

"A great change in future prospects of the growing hop crop for the year has taken place here in the past few days. The yards are struck by the bright and rust, and they are hit hard; the former estimates are reduced one-fourth."

"John Cross, who is a most conservative man, says the crop is hit hard, and the night will surely shorten the crop one-fourth of former estimates given. Many yards will only produce a few on top of the poles, and the light is general throughout the state. We have 45 acres, and we cannot possibly harvest over one-half of what we did last year, under most favorable conditions from now on, and if anything it will fall short of half a crop."

A communication from Court Terry, of Waterville, states that last year he grew 30,000 pounds, and that the same acreage this year will not produce over half of last year's yield. George Allen, who is one of the best-known and most extensive growers around Waterville, states that he has offered his entire crop to a prominent dealer of Waterville, and that the dealer will guarantee him one-half of the amount of hops he grew last year. The proposition was refused by the dealer.

Another communication received from a well-known New York dealer yesterday says the light and rust is quite general throughout the state, and the state will probably not produce over half of last year's crop. It looks now as though it might fall short of this figure.

Another letter from New York yesterday says: "The growers of the Pacific Coast now hold the key to the situation, and if they hold firm, they will give the short seller a jer they will not recover from for some months."

Two reports received yesterday from different districts in California give an almost identical estimate, which is 40,000 to 45,000 bales for 1905.

EXPOSITION CUSTOM HOUSE.

OVER-RIPE BANANAS.

Four Cars Arrive That Were Delayed by Telegraphic Strikes.

Four cars of bananas struck yesterday afternoon in bad condition. They were six days from Billings, having been delayed by the telegraphic strikes. The fruit was over-ripe, and some of the cars may be turned down.

Other receipts included two cars of California peaches, one car of Fresno melons and one car of Louisiana. Peaches were in strong demand, the California bringing 90 cents and the Oregon, which were also more plentiful, selling at 75 cents to \$1. The first Oregon peaches of the season were received from James Nelson, of The Dalles. They brought 75 cents a box.

A shipment of new Merced sweet potatoes came up in the morning, and was offered at 4 1/2 cents a pound. Oregon potatoes were

steady, with a good inquiry for choice stock, which, however, was not plentiful.

Some Poultry Carried Over.

The demand for poultry slackened up considerably in the last half of the week, and quite a number of coops were carried over last evening.

The egg market is steady for strictly fresh stock. Hatching was quiet heavy yesterday, but there was the usual complaint about the quality.

Butter was firm, with a good movement in local brands and a fairly active trade on Front street.
