

BIDS ARE OPENED FOR CANAL WORK

Lowest Is Lower Than Estimate Made by Isthmian Commission.

COMES FROM OLD HANDS

Oliver and Bangs Have Executed Many Large Contracts, Including 800 Locks—Their Profit About \$9,450,000.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 12.—Proposals opened by the Panama Canal Commission today for the entire construction of the Panama Canal were low, and had been expected by experts on construction work. For some time it has been known that several members of the Commission believed 7 per cent on the estimated cost of construction would be fair remuneration for a contractor under the form proposed by the Commission. The lowest proposal that of William J. Oliver of Knoxville, Tenn., and Anson M. Bangs of New York City, who offered to do the work for 67.5 per cent on the estimated cost, is lower than had been expected.

Granting that the estimated cost of the construction of the canal, which has been frequently spoken of in Congress, is accurate, the remuneration of the Oliver-Bangs combination would be \$9,450,000 in excess of the cost of the contract. Much discussion has been caused by the great difference in the only four bids received, as they ranged from 67.5 to 75 per cent.

Veterans at the Business.

William J. Oliver and Anson M. Bangs have been in the contracting business for many years, and the statements they furnished with their proposal show that they have done much important work. Mr. Oliver states that he has completed \$18,000,000 worth of work in 10 years, and now has \$2,750,000 worth of work in prospect. He gives his assets at \$2,000,000.

Great Variation in Bids.

The other bidders were George Peirce & Co., of Frankfort, Me., and New York City, who offered to do the work for 7.19 per cent on the estimated cost; the North American Dredging Company, of Los Angeles, Cal., who offered to do the work for 28 per cent on the estimated cost, and the MacArthur-Gillette Company, of New Jersey, whose bid was 12.5 per cent.

More than 100 contractors and their representatives attended the opening of the bids. Before reading the proposals, Mr. Shonts explained that no bid would be accepted until after the commission had thoroughly studied and investigated it.

Only for Actual Construction.

The Government likewise retains the department of materials and supplies, and, as far as the Panama Railroad is concerned, it expressly was declared in the letter of invitation for bids that it could not wisely be turned over to the contractor. The work to be done by the contractor, therefore, has been limited to the actual work of construction. It is believed by the commission that the estimated cost of completing the canal will be materially reduced by the application of new principles of construction, which will be discovered as the work progresses.

Must Begin in Sixty Days.

The contracts provide that each bidder shall undertake the entire work of construction. No bar was offered to corporations associating in the undertaking, but they were required to be legally organized and to have a contract with which the Government can deal. The Commission did not limit to American contractors the right to put in bids. The actual work of constructing the canal is to begin in sixty days, for signing the contract and the contractor will take over all employees on the Isthmus whom the Commission does not wish to retain. The percentage system that no American employe is to work more than eight hours. There is no time limit for the completion of the canal. The percentage system was adopted because this method is being employed increasingly by the most successful corporations in the country.

Bangs Head of Federal Company.

NEW YORK, Jan. 12.—Anson M. Bangs, who was at the Panama Railroad, was the contractor for completing the Panama Canal, is president of the Federal Construction Company, of this city which is capitalized at \$10,000,000. The directors are Anson M. Bangs, John F. Donovan and James Hughes. Associated with the company is the sub-contracting firm of Hughes Bros. & Bangs, which is composed of James Hughes and Anson M. Bangs.

INDIAN CHIEF MURDERED

Terry, of the Shoshones, Clubbed and Cut to Pieces.

DENVER, Colo., Jan. 12.—A special reporter from the Panhandle states that Terry, head of the Shoshone Indian Council, was murdered Thursday night as he came out of the Council Lodge of the Indian reservation. He was first knocked down with a war club and his body was then cut to pieces with knives. The murder is supposed to be the outcome of a family feud. No arrests have been made, but suspicion points strongly to several Indians. Terry was the half-breed son of the former famous Mormon Bishop Terry, of Utah. He was a squawman, and had

lived on the Shoshone reservation for more than 25 years. There are several factions among the Indians, and as Terry's name was recently burned by the notorious fire, evidently of incendiary origin, it is believed that the crime was committed by some of them. The Shoshone reservation is situated on the Washington will, it is believed by leading citizens, lead to grave disturbances among the Indians, who have been held in restraint by a small military force. The Shoshone and Arapahoe are sworn enemies, and there are factions in both tribes ready to fight at any time.

MIGRATION TO AMERICA

000,000, which was an increase in one year of more than \$4,000,000. Even the Crocker, who has few number, sent home over \$900,000 last year. As the Christmas season approaches, the volume of cheap travel to Europe always increases. Inquiry develops the fact that many foreigners visit their old homes at intervals. Whenever there is a strike at the coal mines or at any of the large works where foreigners are employed, there is an immediate exodus for Europe. Surely this is a land of plenty when it sends the alien laborer with a living for himself, assistance for his absent loved ones and holiday excursions across the Atlantic.

Last year we attracted more immigrants from Italy than from any other nation. Now, how does this wonderful United States compare with that country from which they came? Italy has a public debt of \$78.85 per capita; the United States has a National debt of \$11.51 per capita. Italy has a money circulation per capita of \$9.75, while the United States has a money circulation of \$33.08 per capita. In other words, should a direct and immediate tax be levied for the payment of our National debt (an impossible contingency used merely for illustration) the United States would have a balance of \$21.57 per capita, while Italy, if she paid the whole amount of money in circulation, would still owe \$68.10 per capita, or about four-fifths of her whole debt.

Would Depopulate Chicago.

A good illustration of the number of people coming to this country from Italy may be had by the following statement: If the immigration into the United States from Italy last year had been followed by an emigration from the United States to any other country in the same proportion and all these emigrants had gone from the city of Chicago, there would now be only 63 residents in the great metropolis of the Middle West.

Since the foundation of our Republic the magic of its name has drawn 25,000,000 men and women across the seas. If they had all come from Spain, Sweden and Norway, there wouldn't be a single inhabitant left today in the three kingdoms mentioned. The movement to America is distinguished from all other migrations in that it has drawn, not driven, the great intra-European migrations, the "folk-wandering" of the fifth and sixth centuries of the Christian era that resulted in the overthrow of the Roman Empire by the German tribes, was a movement of the kind that is now being forced their serfs and retainers to sit down to strike out for victory and wealth, but the tide of home-seekers that has swept to America was a movement inspired by the individual seeking to better his condition. Last year alone some 1,000,000 people, and yet great is the land which receives him that, while Europe has 114 persons to the square mile of territory, North America has but 35, and the United States proper but 28 persons to the square mile.

Pilgrimage of Israel Outdone.

In searching history for some comparison of migration, it seems that the pilgrimage of the Israelites was the first great "trek" of which we have an authentic account. It is believed that there were about a million people involved in that movement, which lasted 40 years. During a similar period the United States has attracted 20,000,000 home-seekers, so that as a drawing card, our country seems to outrank Canaan by 20 to 1.

Calab and Joshua told the Israelites the promised land was so rich that it was flowing with milk and honey. Let us see how we can show up with Canaan on this score. Last year alone San's corn produced enough to butter 100,000,000 people, and yet our bees are annually producing \$100,000,000 worth of honey, which would surely be enough to feed the Israelites. The proceeds of our annual tobacco crop would reproduce the Temple of Solomon and add a few modern furnishings that the early spirit had not reckoned upon.

Drawn, Not Driven.

In all the other migrations which have affected the history of the world, the movement has been a conquering one. Weaker nations have been overrun by stronger ones. Sometimes cultivation has been introduced by barbarians, and the millions that come to America come not to conquer but to be conquered; not to change, but to be changed. Since the Civil War we have required that the foreigner be naturalized, and yet our nationality, our governmental system, our modes and thoughts and purposes are unchanged. Could the National individuality of any people have been preserved under the same conditions? Suppose half a million Americans were to go into Germany each year. The rapid assimilation of foreigners to our ideals is accomplished through the medium of the little red schoolhouse. Last year we gave free instruction in English to 1,000,000 children, and there are inhabitants in the kingdom of Spain, that proud Spain which once ruled the world. Think of it! Free education for 1,000,000 children, and yet the number of immigrants is increasing all the while, with the extension of the laws compelling children to go to school where they will or not.

What Attracts Immigrants.

The political equality in America, as well as the material advantages, tends to draw men to our shores. In many cases the religious freedom, which is even before they are naturalized, merely by declaring their intention to become citizens. This great country of ours offers equal advantages to all. Senator Knute Nelson of Minnesota, one of the most highly respected members of the Senate, was a poor boy in Norway. Anton Eichholtz, Republican Representative from Illinois, was born in Bohemia. Richard Bartholdt, a Republican leader in the House, was an immigrant from Germany. Bourke Cockran, the foremost orator in Congress, was born in Ireland and reared in France. Another feature of the attractiveness of America is the absolute guarantee of religious freedom, not only to worship as one sees fit, but to be privileged to participate in public life without discrimination on account of creed. BREAKS HER SHELL

China Flinging Off Traditions for Modern Ways.

REFORMS IN GOVERNMENT

Reorganization Commissions Break Away From the Old and Adapting Laws to Times—Many Decisive Changes Made.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 12.—A comprehensive review of the remarkable change that is taking place in China as a result of the promulgation of the general decree reorganizing the Chinese government is applied to the State Department by Edward T. Williams, Chinese Secretary to the American Legation at Peking.

Reciting the orders for the formation of the two commissions which were to deal with reform projects, Mr. Williams says that for over a month past these commissions have been holding daily sessions, wherein two strong parties have been struggling for leadership, one bent on securing a liberal government on modern lines and the other determined that there shall be no departure from the traditions of the fathers. So far as it has gone, the reform is conspicuous, but many valuable features are retained.

Dead Hand Weighs Heavily

Particularly worthy of note is the abandonment of the scheme for a Cabinet and of the proposed consolidation of the Council of Customs Affairs with the new Board of Finance, probably because of foreign opposition to further interference with the customs administration. The editor itself thinks that the great difficulty which has been encountered in the reform movement is to show either that it is not an innovation, or at least that it is not hostile to the spirit of the fathers. The chief feature in the edict is the manifest endeavor to approach the ideal of "one man, one office." Equally important is the abolition of the useless multiplying of offices, and the exception of the Board of Foreign Relations, whose composition cannot be changed without permission from the powers, they would send an important message to each of the governing boards. Some of the old designations are quite obsolete and the titles have been modernized. The Board of Punishments has never fully described in the title. It will now be called the Board of Law, corresponding with our Department of Justice.

Not Ripe for Parliament.

While the time is not ripe for the establishment of a Parliament, a partial substitute is afforded by the appointment of a council to assist in government, which is to become the mouthpiece of the people, though they are not permitted to nominate or elect its members. The measure is retained as a terror to corrupt, incompetent officials. The press is yet in its infancy in China and is said to be characterized by such venality as to make it unwise to give it a full measure of liberty. Some obsolete institutions have been abolished or incorporated with other boards, such as the "Court of Sacrificial

Worship of the "Court of Imperial Entertainments," and of those functions have been taken over by the "Board of Rights," and the "Court of the Imperial Stud," which has been taken over by the "Board of the Army."

Reforms Still Being Made.

Mr. Williams calls attention to the fact that the Commissions are continuing their work of reform and the report forming the basis of the edict already issued by the "Board of Rights," and this is said to be a greater task than that already completed.
